

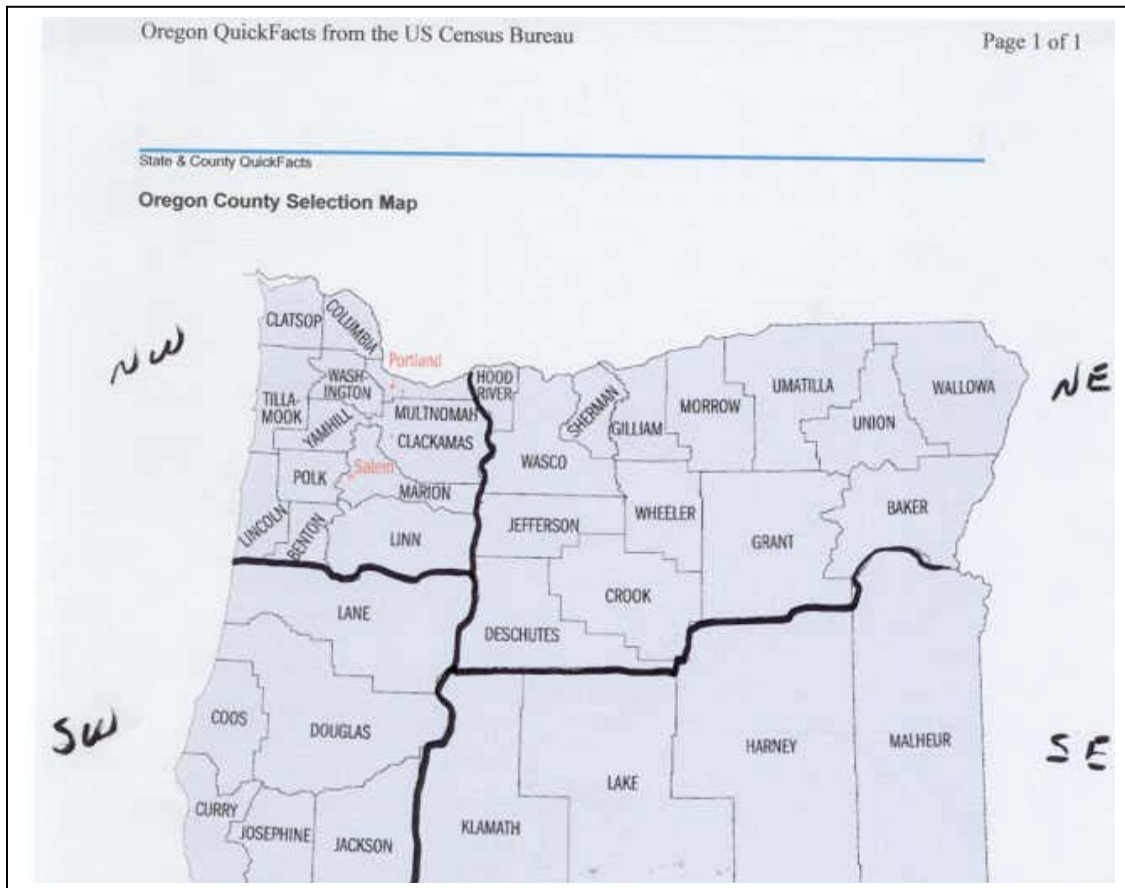

Pa 2 CRAWDAD FEAST: Connie, N7RBH, and I were camping with Frank, K3UHF, and his children, this summer at Timothy Lake. Toward the end of the week, we were joine3d by Frank's XYL, Darcy. We had reservations at Oak Fork Camp ground. The spot I had was very difficult to get into, the one Frank had was nearly imposable to get into, we both had trailers. If you are considering a camp out with a trailer or larger motor home at any of the forest service camp grounds around Timothy Lake, it would be wise to check out the spot before reserving it; you might not be able to get into it. All spots would be good for tents. It was also almost a dry camp. There was a hand pump in working order. No sewer dump. The fishing was fair; we caught cokonie and rainbow trout. I checked into the O.E.N. mobile from my pickup with a Yaesu FT 100 D, using a Lakeview whip. From the trailer I checked in portable, using a Kenwood ts-50 and the hustler whip. Most of the time I was relayed in. I think Larry, W7LJB, was the kind person who relayed me in most of the time.

Our most interesting catch was crawdads. Frank had the traps for the creatures, and over the 8 days we were there, we picked up a good mess of those ugly little critters. Frank cooked them up one night, boiled them for five minutes, and then let the water cool for about 20 minutes. After that we were breaking off the tails, and I was enjoying my first taste of crawdads. The only thing I can compare them to is lobster, and to me, they were better than lobster. You had to work a lot harder to get the meat out of the tail though, and there was not a lot of meat there. In other words, you work for your chow when you eat crawdads.

I never figured on crawdads to settle the growl in my stomach, but I guess I will eat anything once. Andy's twin sister, age ten, enjoyed fishing more than she did catching crawdads. (continued pa 3)

OREGON EMERGENCY NET ANNUAL MEETING

August 22, 2010 Yachts, OR Carol Dorning's, N7HEH The meeting was called to order by the Chairman of the Board K7MKN at 1:35 PM. The Board Members present were K7RFO, K7MKN, WA7FIV, & W7BXD. Those present were KD7HB, KA7LUF, W7TNY, W7WLL, WB6MFV, AB7ET, W7LJB, KA7HBB, KG7UY & W7JDE. The minutes were read and approved and were seconded by W7BXD. The treasurer ND7V gave the treasure report and there was \$796.66 in the account.

(6) There was no Old Business but the old map and the new map were sent around so others could see the new boundaries. There are now three Directors at Large and four Board Members.

W7BXD brought up that the by-laws say there should be five board members to make a quorum, but there has never been five at a board meeting. For years it has been done with a majority which is four. Net Manager suggests that the by-laws be redone to say four instead of the five. A motion was made by WA7FIV to have it changed and 2nd by K7RFO.

KA7LUF was wondering with winter conditions if we could move the net up one hour. Members present mentioned that with other nets and etc. it probably wasn't a very good idea. KD7HB brought up the frustration when relaying, and knowing the internet procedures that others use are always a jump ahead, so why relay when you are competing against a computer. Those present that use the Internet say that those other relays are important and that they don't hear everything. In case of an emergency the relay stations are still very important and they encourage them to keep doing what they do.

The Net Manager sends monthly reports into the STM, and at times it is impossible to get net reports from some of the net controls. The Net Manager must have them by the 5th of the month. The Board thinks it is important keep doing so, WA7FIV, made a suggestion to send a notice to all net controls that their net reports be in by that time. This was agreed by all Board Members.

Ruth, K7RFO made a motion that the three-month, Oct. Nov. & Dec. be reinstated. This is for election purposes to see if you are qualified to run for the Board. She didn't think it was fair that the Net Manager has to monitor every net for three months, this would take a load off the Net Manger. It was approved by all Board Members and 2nd by WA7FIV.
