The minutes were read and a motion was made by WA7FIV, to accept the minutes as read and was 2nd by K7RFO. The treasurer's report was given by ND7V there

(6) was \$775.86 in the bank, motion was made by K7RFO to accept the treasurer's report and was 2^{nd} by W7BXD.

N7RBO the Net Manager/Secretary asked that the 3 month check-in list be abolished but all Net Controls must keep those 3 months rosters just in case they need to be reviewed, the check-in list seemed to be too confusing and she ended up redoing all except for a few. N7IPG was asked a few years ago to re-write the OEN hand book. He came up with new Guidelines and Policies gave a copy to each Board Member. A motion was made to see if the Board should form a committee to read and make suggestions on the new Guidelines and Policies. This motion failed to pass.

With no other business the meeting was adjourned at 1:45 pm.
