JUST GOOD CHOW by Connie N7RBH---DREAMY CHOCOLATE PEANUT BUTTER FUDGE 2 cups canned pumpkin, 1 pkg 18.3 oz Betty Crocker Fudge Brownies Traditional Chewy Brownie Mix. 2 Tbs reduced fat peanut butter at room temperature. Preheat oven to 350 deg. Coat a 9 inch square pan with cooking spray, cook for 35 minutes in a large bowl. Combine pumpkin with brownie mix, stir until smooth. Batter will be thick but don't put anything in it to thin it. Put

(3) batter in the pan and spread out evenly. Smooth peanut butter on top, swirl it around on top. The batter will remain very thick and fuggy. It looks like it is uncooked. Cool it and cover it with foil, and refrigerate for at least two hours before cutting.
