THE OREGON EMERGENCY MEETS ON OR ABOUT 3980. We all need to remember that net control determines the net frequency. I have heard folks advise the net control he was not on frequency. Net control is ALWAYS on frequency if he is on or about 3980. (ed)

I am respectfully asking that the members (and non-members) who check into the OEN to please use 3980 LSB. The OEN Net Control Station is receiving and transmitting on or about 3980 LSB. I realize that CW (and other modes as well) work more efficiently than phone when propagation is bad. In an emergency situation, every effort would be made to copy the CW station if that was the only thing getting through, or if that is the only transmit mode you have during an emergency.

That being said the OEN has always been a phone net, first on AM, now on LSB as that technology advanced. I would ask that you respect the Net Control Stations and the OEN by checking in on the same frequency as the NCS, in LSB mode. The disruption (under normal propagation) that ANY other mode causes the net is NOT for the good of the net.

Can anyone imagine a qualified CW operator checking into a CW net in any mode other than CW just because he or she could? How would that make any sense and what would be the reaction by the CW Net members?

2 We do have lots of members who are very skilled at CW, and they have every right to be proud of that skill. I wish I was one of them in that respect.

If you enjoy CW, by all means pursue it, check into a CW net or look up others on CW to talk to. It is the same for all the other modes. Pursue your passion in amateur radio whatever it is.

The fact remains that checking into ANY Net using any other mode than the mode that the Net is set up for is rude and disrespectful to the Net as well as the Net control Station(the exception being if it is an emergency and it is the only mode that works to get through).
