She is so sweet and the best of the best net controls we have ever heard! Ruthie is so special!. I am timid to try and do relays since Ruth is so very good at it! She can take a pile up of three and come out with each one correctly, she is amazing! We here in La Pine have the up-most respect and love for Ruthie!! ----WELL LETS DO THAT BEVERLY----Our Ruth was born in Alabama. Thank goodness for us, she ended up here in Klamath Falls, Oregon. K7RFO is her original call. It was her husband of the time, Dean Lewis, k7btr, who inspired her to become a ham. Ruth has been a member of the O.E.N. since 1961. She holds certificate number 413.

Ruth was a net control of the O.E.N. from 1962 to

1972. She ended up going to work at J.C. Penny here in Klamath Falls, and her hours of work would not allow her to check into the net. She was a member of the board of directors of the O.E.N. in the late 1960's. Today she is a current member of the board. Some years back Ruth started calling the net just like she did in the 60's. Health problems keep her from doing that now, but she sure does miss doing it.

Ruth was a member of the Klamath Basin Amateur Radio Association even before she became a ham. She joined that group in 1959, when it still met at the Klamath County Fair Grounds, in a horse stall. She has held several offices in K-BAR-A, including president, secretary, and treasurer. She has been one of the driving forces behind K-BAR-A. If anything was going on with the club, you could bet Ruth was there. She was always there to help with the Crater Lake rim run, K-BAR-A still provides communications for that event, in Aug. at Crater Lake. Ruth has always given freely of her time to amateur radio events in the Klamath Falls area. She hardly ever has missed a club meeting (I used to go to those meetings just so I at K-BAR-A. could get one of the delicious cream puffs she makes)

Ruth is active on the 146.85 repeater net here in Klamath Falls. She was a net control there for 40 years. Ruth has been a ham for 54 years. The O.E.N. and her local two meter net are the only nets Ruth checks into these days.

I ask Ruth if she had ever done a CW net. She said no. Her husband wanted her to learn the code, and she did. Her first license was a conditional. She up graded to general, and today holds an advanced license.

Other interests Ruth have are that she loves to crochet, and knit. Some of us have blankets she gave us at an O.E.N. picnic.

Another question I ask Ruth is what was your first rig? Her transmitter was a Heath Appche. Her receiver was a Hammarlund hq-180.

It has been an honor for me to have known Ruth for so many years, I worked with her in K-BAR-A and continue to do that in the Oregon Emergency Net. Thank you Ruth just for being the wonderful person was you
